- Public school districts with AD time: Milpitas is FT; SJUSD depends role on population; 1500 or above is FT. ESUSD is .4 per school (receives stipend about \$5000). Morgan Hill is .8, LAMVUSD: teach 1 class (\$7000 stipend); Salinas UHSD is FT, but they are TSA on teachers salary plus stipend (about \$11,000) and cell phone allowance. FUHSD, teach 2 classes (\$15,000 stipend). LGSUHSD teach 2 classes, plus stipend (\$15,000 stipend). Sequoia SD teach 2.5 classes plus stipend (\$13,668), depending on school site.
