 - Duane Morgan spoke about the CCS Administration workshops and gave an update on CCS league re-alignment.
 - Marco Sanchez spoke about CCS Sportsmanship games, there are 60 basketball Sportsmanship games that helps to raise money for the scholarships. CIF Model coach submissions are due on Nov 15. There have been 15 ejections thus far, 9 football and 6 water polo.

CIF Home also has features to track clearance forms, coach's clearance and can import games.

 - Discussion about Campus Safety
 - Some schools have campus security for school day only. Some schools have campus security during school and after school. Most schools have security, not police officers. All schools have police officers for football games. Some schools have metal detectors for game entry, some do not allow bags into their events.
 - ScorebookLive.com
 - Not many people are using. Many are finding the transition from MaxPreps to ScorebookLive.com difficult, not as user friendly. People want an Android app for ScorebookLive. There is a glitch in communication between ScorebookLive and Home Campus. PSAL is still using MaxPreps.
 - Sportsmanship
 - There was a record number of ejections in the CCS opening weekend. What can we do on our campus to teach the student-athletes to control their emotions in the heat of competition? One school shows a video during the team's locker talks about sportsmanship, some schools require Positive Coaching Alliance workshops for kids and for parents, one school recognizes good sportsmanship with a t-shirt, one school has Positive Coaching Alliance do a workshop for the freshman class in their PE/Health class so that every freshman is exposed to positive coaching alliance. One school has a spectator boot camp, teaching fans how to behave during games.
